Have you ever wanted to publish your ideas in a journal or prepare research proposals? This interactive 2 hour workshop will provide you with information, guidance and feedback on writing for publication in the AENJ and other leading journals.

How will the workshop be run? The workshop will commence with a presentation that outlines the steps to success in publishing and research. Attendees will work in small groups and work up their publication and research proposals. Mentor/s will provide individual support, feedback and encouragement to achieve your goal. Throughout the workshop you will be discussing and refining your publications or proposals with other workshop participants and mentors.

What will I learn/or take home from this workshop? At the end of this workshop:

- attendees will leave the workshop with concrete examples of ways to improve journal writing skills
- strategies and advice to increase the likelihood of publication.
- a detailed plan of a manuscript
- a range of strategies and tools to help you prepare a successful manuscript
- assistance through mentoring if you wish further support with your writing and the submission process
- a certificate of attendance

What pre-workshop preparation will I need to do? You will be required to prepare and bring along a draft manuscript of your publication, or your ideas for a research topic.
